If you plan to work on the vessel yourself, please make sure that the craft is ready to be launched by the specified launch date. Otherwise, depending on the circumstances of the delay, you may incur a Relocation Fee. Therefore, the specified Launch Date should be the (latest) date by which your vessel is expected to be ready for launch. Your vessel will be launched on or shortly after the specified launch date, or earlier if mutually convenient. Please leave outdrive(s) in the up position and ensure we have a set of keys for your vessel.
